



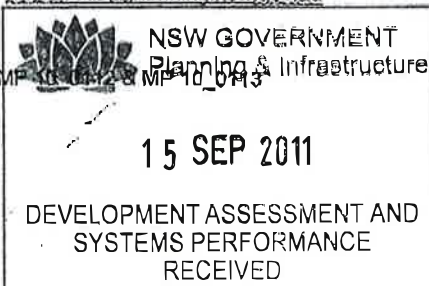

Subject: Exhibition of Mixed Use Development – 110-114 Herring Road, Macquarie Park (MP 10 0112 and MP10 0113)

Stamford Property Services has submitted an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the above proposed project. Concept Plan approval is sought for 7 building envelopes ranging in height from 2 to 22 storeys with a maximum gross floor area of 56,892m². Project approval for Stage 1 is also sought, which includes demolition of existing buildings, construction of basement car parking and four buildings with a proposed 29,524m² gross floor area to accommodate 310 residential units and landscaping.

The EA may be viewed on the Department's website (majorprojects.planning.nsw.gov.au). The EA will also be on exhibition from **Wednesday 10 August 2011** until **Wednesday 14 September 2011** during regular business hours, at:
