

Flood Prone Land (Including SSDCP 2006)

High Flood Risk

Areas below the Flood Planning Level with significant evacuation difficulties.

Medium Flood Risk

Areas below the Flood Planning Level with no significant evacuation difficulties.

Low Flood Risk

Areas within the floodplain that have low risk but are within the extent of the Probable Maximum Flood (PMF).

Initial Assessment

Areas of potential flood liable land where a flood risk management plan is yet to be completed.

Note: Areas shown as High and Medium Risk also represent the Flood Planning Area under SSLEP 2006.
