

BYLAW

1. DISABLED CAR SPACES

- 1.1 An owner or occupier of a lot must not park or stand any motor or other vehicle in a disabled carparking space except with the written approval of the owners corporation.
- 1.2 In the event that an owner or occupier of a lot is a person with a disability and requires the use of the disabled carparking space, then the owners corporation must grant exclusive use of the disabled carparking space to that owner or occupier's at no costs for as long as the owner or occupier is in occupation of a lot.

RESTRICTION ON USE TO BE REGISTERED ON COMMON PROPERTY TITLE

No disabled vehicle spaces in the common property is to be used for the parking or storage of vehicles, boats, trailers or the like without the consent of the owners corporation. The owners corporation shall grant and/or permit an owner or occupier of a lot with a disability the exclusive right to use disabled vehicle spaces in the common property for as long as the owner or occupier is in occupation of a lot.
