My objection is due to Traffic Conjestion

The proposed development is significantly larger than any other existing development in the Sutherland Shire and is inappropriate for the area.

The surrounding roads could not cope with the additional traffic generated by 700 units, and a Shopping Centre, and an expanded club. Especially when allowing the the additional dwelling at Greenhills and other organic growth in the eastern end of the shire.

The road access to and from the site is limited to a small number of roads which I do not believe can cope with significant increase in traff ic volumes without severe delays.

A traffic study included in the EA submitted by the developers, found the project would generate 1249 two-way vehicle movements an hour during the Friday afternoon peak period and 1060 vehicle movements during the Saturday afternoon peak period.

There is no room for the expansion of these roads.

In my view, the increased traffic will be detrimental to all stakeholders in the area, including residents, visitors to the beaches, school children, sharks supporters and so on.

I would support a more modest, lower density, development that is more in keeping with the area, its past and its future and I stuggle to see how high density housing is part of north woolooware's future. There are many other suburbs where this sort of development would be more appropriate.
