Greg,

Nice to catch up with you on the phone.

As mentioned, the NSW Government announced the Western Express Rail Program as part of its Metropolitan Transport Plan in February this year.

A key component of Western Express is the proposed City Relief Line, running underground between Redfern and Wynyard. Western Express is being developed on behalf of Rail Corp by the Transport Infrastructure Division of Transport NSW.

We are in the preliminary planning stages for this project, and expect to proceed to a Preliminary Environmental Assessment by the middle of next year.

Construction is expected to commence in late 2012, and the first trains would be running by late 2018.

We have been working closely with the Redfern Waterloo Authority on our proposals, and they passed on your contact details to me.

As we will very much be neighbours (and construction neighbours as well) it would be very timely for Chris Meale, the Western Express Project Director and myself to meet with you to firstly make contact with you and set up lines of communications, as well as to explain a little more about Western Express and to learn more about the Pumulwuy Project and its timelines.
