**REMONDIS ALTERNATIVE WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY (10_0028)

Dear Sir/Madam

I refer to your letter of 14 February 2012 (Ref: 10_0028), regarding the abovementioned Development Application which was referred to Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) for comment in accordance with Clause 104 of State Environmental Planning Policy (Infrastructure) 2007. I wish to advise that the Sydney Regional Development Advisory Committee (SRDAC) considered the traffic impact of this application at its meeting on 14 March 2012.

Below are the Committee's recommendations and RMS's comments on the subject application:

1. It is noted that the current modelled traffic queue length is 225 metres along Grand Avenue from James Ruse Drive intersection during afternoon (1:30 pm – 2:30 pm). The main access to this development off Grand Avenue is located some 250 meters away from this intersection. Future background traffic growth may result in the formation of longer westbound traffic queues along Grand Avenue and hence vehicles would not be able to turn right out of Grand Avenue North into Grand Avenue.
2. RMS (former RTA) has requested a Road Safety Audit to be undertaken at the intersection of Grand Avenue and Grand Avenue North. It is important a Road Safety Audit is undertaken and submitted to RMS for review prior to the determination of this application. Up to date the Road Safety Audit report has not been submitted to RMS for review.
3. Swept paths are required to be submitted to RMS for review for vehicles turning right into and out of Grand Avenue North at its intersection with Grand Avenue. The design vehicle adopted for swept analysis should be the largest size vehicle intended to service the site.
